Mr. Alfred Mason Pearson, 88, of Royston, GA passed away on Saturday, January 4, 2020, at the Brown Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mr. Pearson was born in Franklin County, GA on August 18, 1931, son of the late John and Martha Alewine Pearson.
