Betty Jo Mayo Boswell, born in Norwood GA, daughter of the late John Edward and Alice Lorene (Jordan) Mayo, passed away peacefully on Sunday, January 29, 2023, after suffering from long-term illnesses. Betty was preceded in death by her husband and life-love, Bobby Ray Boswell, her brother, Larry Mayo, and Larry's wife Paulette.

Betty is survived by her sister, Linda Mayo Ayers and husband Barry of Vanna. Betty and Bobby have three adult children, all married, ten grandchildren with their seven spouses, and nine great-grandchildren: Bob Boswell, Jr. and wife Karen of Lilburn, GA, John Boswell and wife Susan of Jefferson, GA, and Renee Boswell Brown and husband Larry of Lavonia, GA. Betty was a lifelong member of Peniel Pentecostal Holiness Church and served the church for many decades in multiple capacities, including Sunday School teacher, Secretary-Treasurer, choir member, and all areas of Women's Ministries.

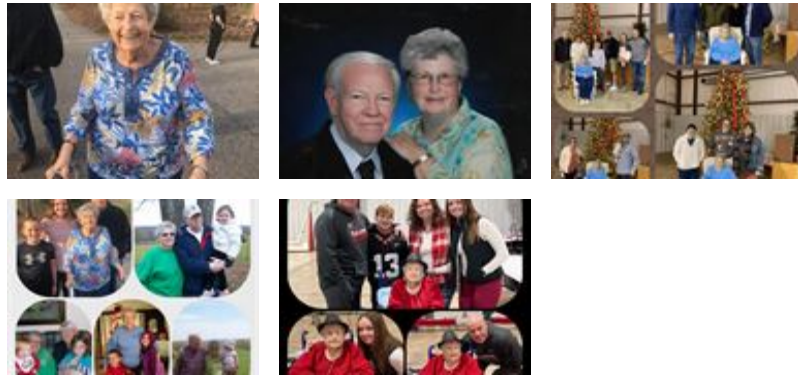

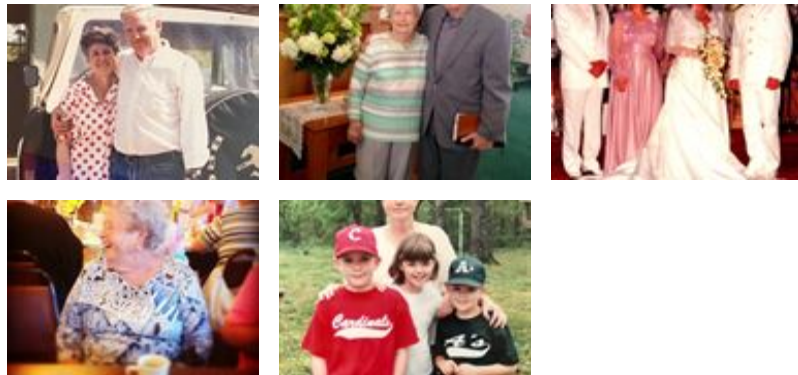
