Mrs. Betty Nabors Brown, 84, of Royston, GA passed away on Monday, September 18, 2017, at the St. Mary's Sacred Heart Hospital in Lavonia, GA.

Mrs. Brown was born in Greenwood, SC on May 11, 1933, daughter of the late Algie Wayne Nabors, Sr. and the late Molly Bramblet Nabors. She was a retired LPN having worked with Ty Cobb Memorial Hospital for 55 years. Mrs. Brown was a member of the Royston Baptist Church, a member of the Daughters of the Confederacy and a hospice volunteer in the 1970's and 1980's. She was centered around the care of others. 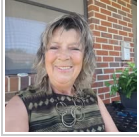
