Mrs. Mary Blanche Kelley Sayer, 98, of Bowersville, GA passed away on Sunday, April 15, 2018, at the Hartwell Health and Rehabilitation Center in Hartwell, GA.

Mrs. Sayer was born in Franklin County, GA on March 9, 1920, daughter of the late William Thomas Kelley and the late Pearl Allen Kelley. She was a seamstress having worked for numerous sewing plants and was a member of the Bowersville First United Methodist Church; where she was a Sunday School teacher, member of the Quilting Club, and part of the United Methodist Women. Mrs. Sayer was also a Pink Lady at Ty Cobb Memorial Hospital.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Pleas John Sayer; brother, Frank Kelley; sisters, Lettie Fulghum and Lois Vansickle; and great grandson, Hogan Sayer Dominy.
