Carolyn Moore Brown, 64, of Athens, Georgia died on Monday, September 1, 2014 at Athens Regional Hospital. Carolyn was born at Charity Hospital in New Orleans, LA on February 1, 1950. She was the daughter of the late Dr. Stewart D. Brown Jr. and Mrs. Roberta M. Brown of Royston, Georgia. Carolyn was afflicted with Cerebral Palsy. Carolyn had a severe disorder, but she was quite astute and aware. She was able to use her intelligence to help with technology in communicating with an augmentative communication board. She was able to tour the state of Georgia demonstrating her communication and cognitive skills and she was an integral part in helping doctors prove that people with Cerebral Palsy do have cognitive abilities.

Carolyn is survived by her siblings, Barbara Brown Whitney of Clemson, SC, Stewart D. Brown III and Katie P. Brown of Gainesville, GA, Dr. Robert M. Brown and Debbie B.
