Mrs. Catherine Jane James Haley, 101, of Royston, GA passed away on Wednesday, March 02, 2016, at the Athens Regional Medical Center in Athens, GA.

She was a 1935 graduate of Anderson College and after college worked as a seamstress for Oxford Manufacturing. 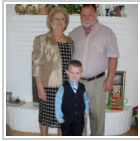

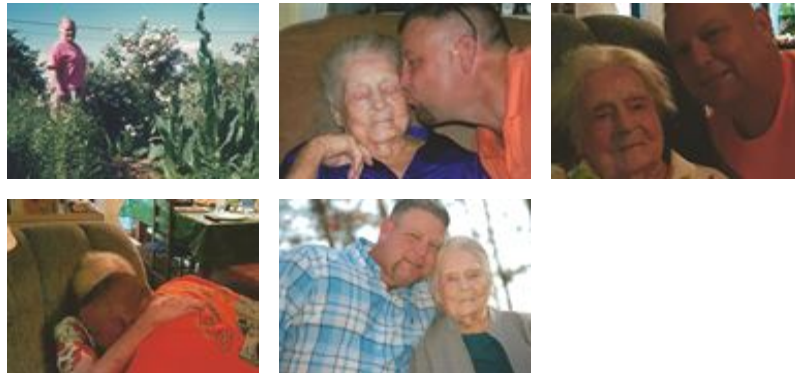

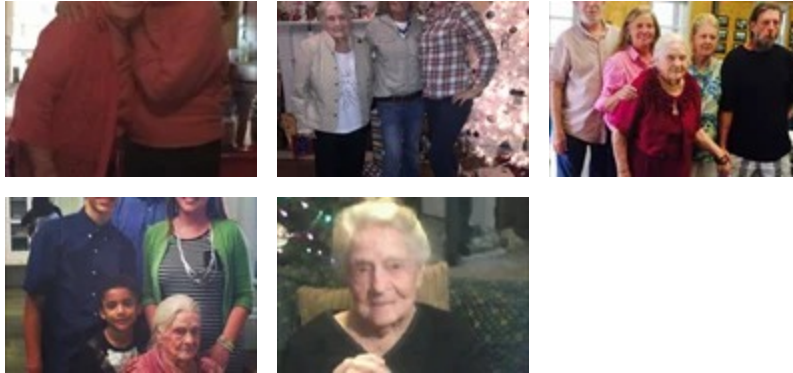
