Mr. Charles Jarrell Martin, 82, of Royston, GA passed away on Wednesday, January 02, 2019, at the Hartwell Health and Rehabilitation Center in Hartwell, Georgia.

Mr. Martin was born in Canon, Georgia on November 25, 1936, son of the late Lonnie Gerome Martin and the late Velma Starr Martin. He was shift manager for Columbia Nitrogen and was a member of the Royston First United Methodist Church in Royston.

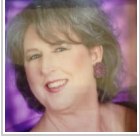
