Miss Cheryll Leila Watson, 80, of Carnesville, GA passed away on Thursday, October 24, 2019, at Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center.

Miss Watson was born on February 22, 1939 in Detroit, Michigan, daughter of the late Martin P. Watson and the late Pauline Price Watson. She was a head teller having worked at Northeast Georgia Bank and a member of Middle River Baptist Church where she was the treasurer for 50 years and taught the 6-9 year olds in Sunday school.

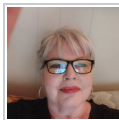
