Mr. Claude Ray "Bo" Greenway, 65, of Royston, GA passed away on Tuesday, May 03, 2016, at the St. Mary's Hospital in Athens, GA.

Mr. Greenway was born on April 16, 1951 in Birmingham, Alabama, son of the late Claude E. Greenway and the late Marjorie Phillips Greenway.
