



## Mr. David Vernon Boswell

February 6, 1932 - July 10, 2024

Mr. David Vernon Boswell, 92, of Royston, GA passed away on Wednesday, July 10, 2024, at his home.

Mr. Boswell was born in Athens, GA on February 6, 1932, son of the late Ellis John Wesley Boswell and the late Clara Gunter Boswell. He was a chief probation officer in Fulton County for over 30 years and was a United States Army veteran. Mr. Boswell was a member of the Royston First United Methodist Church and served as a minister in the South Carolina Conference for 15 years. He worked at Pruitt Funeral Home for 10 years and was also a member of the Royston-Franklin Springs Lion's Club.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, David Vernon Boswell, II; grandson, Christopher Boswell.

Survivors include his wife, Joan Satterwhite Boswell; daughter and son-in-law, Dorothy Boswell Patrick and George Patrick of Loganville, GA; grandchildren, David Shane Boswell and Kristan Boswell; and great-grandchildren, Victoria Boswell and David Shane Boswell, II.

A memorial service for Mr. Boswell will be held at a later date.

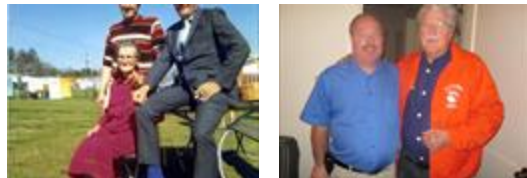
