Mr. Denver Earley Motes, 83, of Carnesville, GA passed away on Sunday, June 27, 2021, at his home.

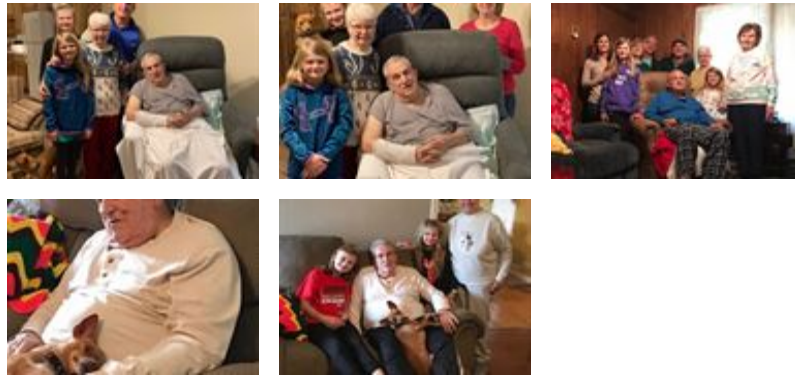
