



Mr. Donald (Don) Douglas Kelemen

Mr. Donald (Don) Douglas Kelemen, 82, of Royston, GA passed away on Sunday, June 1, 2025, at the Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center in Athens, GA.

Mr. Kelemen was born in Norwalk, CT on September 19, 1942, son of the late Andrew Lawrence Kelemen and the late Ann Douglas Kelemen. He was a trend-setting Industrial Designer and a leader in store fixture design, point of purchase merchandising, consumer products and interiors, etc. over his long career. He came from a family of artists, including his grandfather, mother, and sister.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son with Elaine Pierandri Kelemen, Andrew Douglas Kelemen.

Survivors include his wife of 37 years, Bonita Kay Cappel Kelemen, his sister Bonnie Kelemen Evans and her sons Daniel and Douglas, his son, also with Elaine Kelemen, Donald Drew Kelemen of Ridgefield CT, daughter-in-law Mary Jane Bossidy Kelemen and their children Lucy, Andrew and Jane Catherine, son Andrew's wife, Laura Anthony Kelemen and their children Matthew, Adam and Anna Grace, brother-in-law, David Cappel, sisters-in-law, Judith Devlin, Linda Teunis, Patricia Warner and Carol Meli and their families.

Don earned a Bachelor of Industrial Design from Pratt Institute, Brooklyn NY in 1964. During his career, he was a full member of IDSA and the National Computer Graphics Association among others. He created designs for national and international trade shows such as NEOCON, EUROSHOP, JAPANSHOP, ORGATECHNIK, Global Shop, NACs and IDSA conventions. He designed the original interactive (C.A.D.) multimedia terminal and a precision photo plotter.
