



## Mr. Donald Wayne Leard

Donald “Wayne” Leard, 86, of Royston passed away peacefully at his home with family by his side on February 18, 2026.

Born September 27, 1939, he was the son of the late Jesse Morgan and Zephine (Ridgway) Leard. Wayne was a devoted husband, father, grandfather, and loyal friend. His family was the joy of his life, and he expressed his love not only in words, but in steady presence, quiet strength, and unwavering support.

A lifelong member of the Royston First United Methodist Church, Wayne lived out his faith with humility and consistency. His relationship with the Lord shaped the way he treated others – with patience, generosity, and grace. For many years, he owned and operated Leard’s True Value Hardware store in Royston.
