



## Mrs. Doris Troutman Crouch

July 27, 1930 - October 4, 2023

Mrs. Doris Troutman Crouch, 93, of Royston, GA passed away on October 4, 2023, at Brown Health and Rehabilitation Center in Royston, GA.

Mrs. Crouch was born in Troutman, NC on July 27, 1930. She was the daughter of the late Francis Edgar Troutman and the late Ossie Cline Troutman. Doris began her work career at a hosiery mill stitching seams into nylon stockings. She also worked briefly as a bank teller. Doris retired from Wholesale Builder's Supply as the credit office manager and co-owner of the company.

Mrs. Crouch was a talented seamstress and enjoyed knitting, crocheting, reading, and spending time with her family. She was well known for her talent in the kitchen as well and supplied every family event with homemade yeast bread, chocolate chip oatmeal cookies and wedding cookies. Doris also enjoyed gardening and canned green beans until weeks before her death at age 93. She had a green thumb, especially with orchids.

An active member of the Royston First United Methodist Church, Doris was a member of the Crusader's Sunday School class, the Joy Circle and was the coordinator of the blanket ministry. She enjoyed music and loved singing in the choir for many of her 19 years in Royston. Doris' legacy to her church can be seen every Christmas when viewing the almost 200 hand-beaded

Chrismon ornaments that she made. She proudly spent hundreds of hours handcrafting these intricately beaded pearl and gold ornaments.

In addition to her parents, Doris was preceded in death by nine brothers and sisters.

Survivors include her son and daughter-in-law, Rick and Cindy Crouch of Olathe, KS; daughter and son-in-law, Lisa and Tracy Dilworth of Royston; brother, Robert L. Troutman of Raleigh, NC; and grandchildren, Brad Crouch, Roman Crouch, Jackson Dilworth and Ashlyn Dilworth.

Funeral services for Mrs. Crouch will be held at Royston First United Methodist Church at 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 21, 2023, with Rev. Matt Parker officiating. Prior to the funeral service, the family will receive friends at the church from 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. on Saturday afternoon. Interment will follow in the Rose Hill Cemetery in Royston. During other times the family will be at their respective homes.

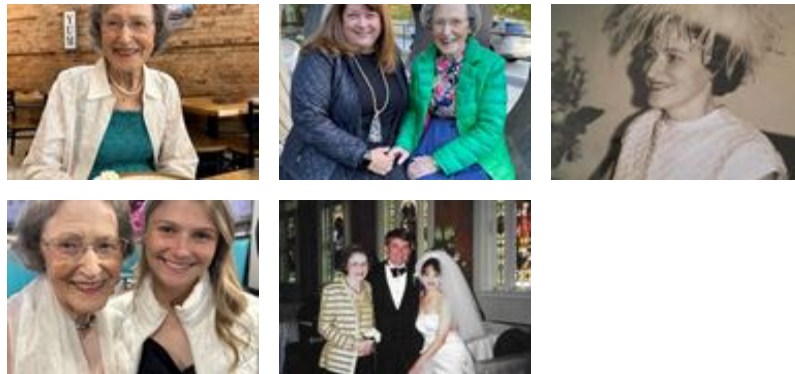
