



## Mr. Dwight Alvin Phillips

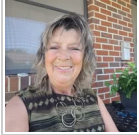

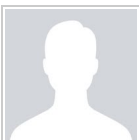

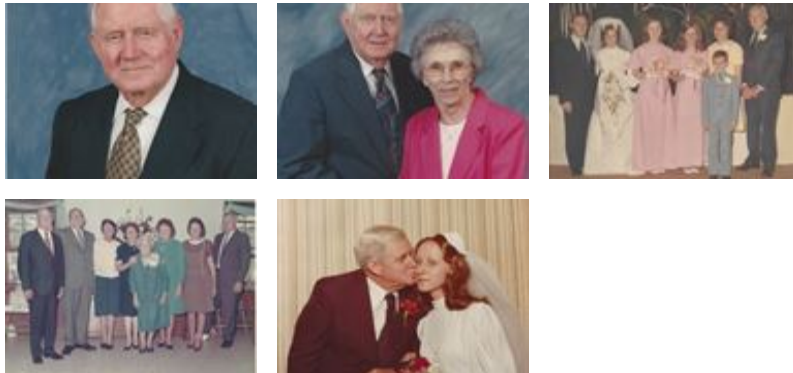
