March 20, 1929 - August 4, 2025

Mr. Ellis Nash, a wonderful father, husband, and a loving and giving member of the Shiloh community died on August 4, 2025.

Mr. Nash was born in Madison County, the son of the late Richard and Della Roland Nash. He was retired from the University of Georgia and Russel Research Center. He was a deacon of the Shiloh Baptist Church and a member of the John H. Jones Masonic Lodge #348. Mr. Nash was the founder of the Shiloh Volunteer Fire Department. He served in the U.S. Air Force and was a Korean War veteran.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his loving wife of 60 years, Faye A. Nash; daughter, Teresa Nash; brothers, J.D. Nash, and Richard Nash; and sister, Dot Wiley.

Survivors include daughter, Elaine Belfield; son and daughter-in-law, Nelson and Kerry C. 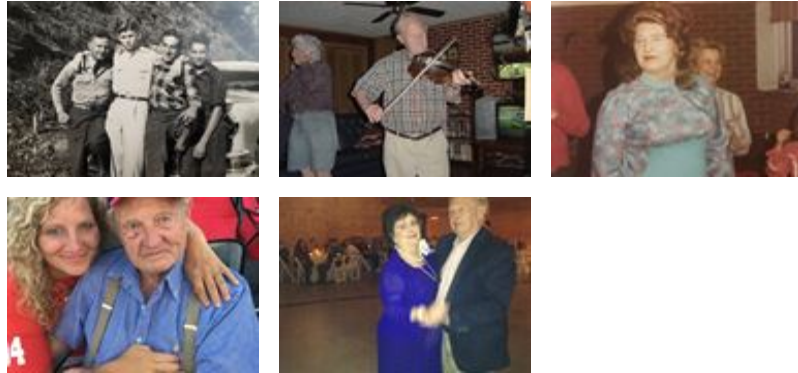
