Mr. Emory Lee Bond, 85, passed away on Wednesday, May 13, 2026, at Piedmont Athens Regional Center.

Mr. Bond was born in Commerce, GA, on September 6, 1940, son of the late Charlie Dewey Bond and the late Ophelia Randall Bond. He retired from Tenneco after 44 years of service. 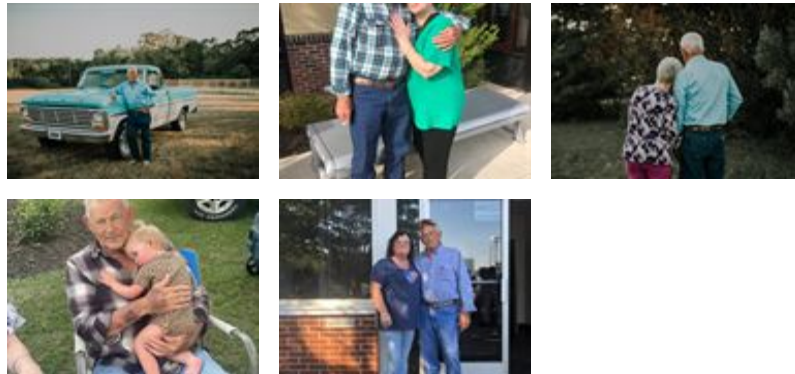
