Mr. Emory Lee Bond, 85, passed away on Wednesday, May 13, 2026, at Piedmont Athens Regional Center.

Mr. Bond was born in Commerce, GA, on September 6, 1940, son of the late Charlie Dewey Bond and the late Ophelia Randall Bond. He retired from Tenneco after 44 years of service. He was a U.S. Army veteran having served during 1963, a deacon at Rice Creek Baptist Church, and a member of Franklin Springs Baptist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his siblings. He was the last surviving member of his family.
