Mrs. Frances Carnes Osley, 90, of Royston, GA passed away on Tuesday, February 23, 2021, at St. Mary's Sacred Heart Hospital in Lavonia, GA.

Mrs. Osley was born on January 7, 1931, daughter of the late William "Buck" and Meander Overcash Carnes. She was a supervisor having worked at Oxford Manufacturing in Bowman, GA. 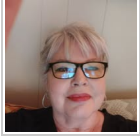
