Mr. Fred Lee Hendrix, 97, of Canon, GA passed away Monday, June 30, 2014, at the Ty Cobb Regional Medical Center in Lavonia, GA.

Mr. Hendrix was born in Royston, GA on November 03, 1916, son of the late Jim Hendrix and the late Clara Bell Bowen Hendrix. He was a material handler for Tenneco Automotive and later was a farmer.
