



Mr. Furman Wilson Fitts

April 20, 1940 - January 13, 2023

Mr. Furman Wilson Fitts, 82, of Danielsville, GA passed away on Friday, January 13, 2023, at the Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center in Athens, GA.

Mr. Fitts was born in Danielsville, GA on April 20, 1940, son of the late William Lafayette Fitts and the late Ethel Elizabeth Moore Fitts. He was an automobile mechanic having worked at Minish GMC Pontiac & Buick and then Mike Dudley's Garage later in life. Mr. Fitts was a United States Army veteran, the former Fire Chief of Shiloh Volunteer Fire Department and of the Christian faith.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by four brothers and three sisters.
