Mrs. Geneva Williams Bennett, 100, of Royston, GA passed away on Friday, February 15, 2019, at her home.

Mrs. Bennett was born on July 26, 1918, daughter of the late Baxter and Vinnie Andrews Williams. She was born in Toccoa, GA, and then moved to Royston where she lived for the last 70 years. Mrs. Bennett attended North Georgia College where she obtained a teaching degree. She taught elementary school and later was a homemaker and substitute teacher. 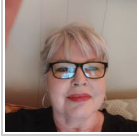

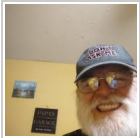

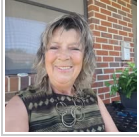
