Mr. George "Blue" Allison Alexander, 92, of Royston, GA passed away on Tuesday, December 13, 2022, at his son's home.

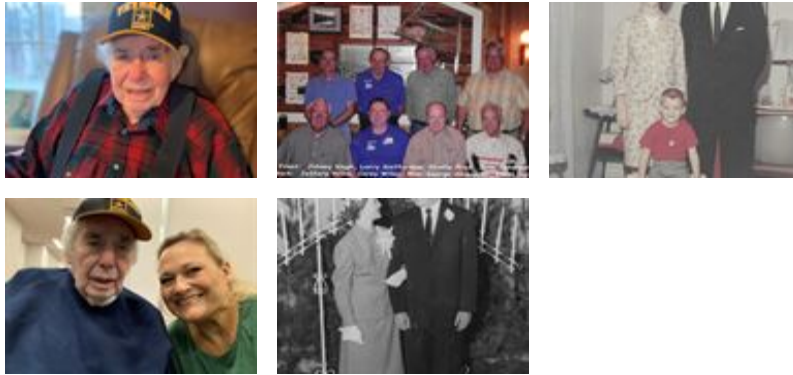
