



## Glenna "Dean" Rice

December 23, 1949 - November 25, 2015

Glenna "Dean" Rice, 65, died peacefully surrounded by love on Wednesday, November 25, 2015, in Augusta, GA, after an extended battle with multiple sclerosis.
