Mr. Herald Edwin Seigler, 85, of Dewy Rose, GA passed away on Thursday, May 2, 2019, at Hart Care Center in Hartwell, GA.

Mr. Seigler was born on October 10, 1933, in Bowman, GA, son of the late Charles Jones Seigler and the late Maude Christian Seigler. He was a retired Lt. Colonel from the U.S. Air Force where he served for 25 years.
