



## Mr. Hubbard Hawkins Conwell

November 10, 1928 - January 1, 2025

Mr. Hubbard Hawkins Conwell, 96, of Comer, GA, passed away on Wednesday, January 1, 2025, at Brown Health and Rehabilitation Center in Royston, GA.

Mr. Conwell was born in Comer, GA, on November 10, 1928, son of the late Hawkins H. Conwell and the late Chester Scarborough Conwell. He was a Shift Engineer having worked at Transcontinental Pipeline for 35 years. He was a member of John H.
