Mr. James "Hoggy" Russell Pulliam, 75, of Danielsville, GA passed away on Sunday, October 16, 2022, at his home.

Mr. Pulliam was born in Royston, GA on August 22, 1947, son of the late J.P. Pulliam and the late Royster Roberts Pulliam. He was an electrician having worked at Westinghouse, was a member of the Electrician's Union and of Trinity Baptist Church in Danielsville.
