Mr. James Joseph Mikuski, 79, of Canon, GA passed away on Friday, September 14, 2018, at St. Mary's Sacred Heart Hospital in Lavonia, GA.

Mr. Mikuski was born on March 13, 1939, in Brattleboro, VT, son of the late John Mikuski and the late Rose Nadeau Mikuski. He was a welder having worked at New Departure and a U.S. Navy veteran having served during the Vietnam War.

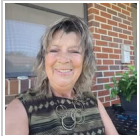
