Buddy graduated from Oglethorpe County High School - Class of 1954. He was baptized at Millstone Baptist Church and is still a member there. He retired from RiverEdge Granite in Elberton where he worked alongside his boys as “QC” and “referee” in his words! He loved every minute of it.

He was an avid outdoorsman and loved fishing at his pond, alongside the beaver that he had a love hate relationship with and a nonstop battle that still exists! His favorite sound was the chirp of bob-white quail. It gave him a smile, every time.

While in the Navy, he kept the post office busy with letters to the love of his life of 67 years, Nancie Lester Ruff. They created a unique family, and they were his whole world.
