Mr. Jessie McGee Garrett, Sr., 93, of Royston, GA passed away on Wednesday, March 17, 2021, at St. Mary's Sacred Heart Hospital.

Mr. Garrett was born in Mount Airy, GA on May 19, 1927, son of the late Judge H. Garrett and the late Ollie Loudermilk Garrett. He was the former owner and operator of Goldmine Truck Stop and a member of the Harrison Lee McCrary VFW Post #4828. He was a U.S. Army veteran having fought during World War II and was a member of Grace Baptist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Virginia Hautence Strickland Garrett; son, Jessie McGee Garrett, Jr.; and daughter, Linda Garrett Cawley.

A graveside service for Mr. Garrett will be held at Mount Bethel Church of God Cemetery on Saturday, March 20, 2021, at 2:00 p.m. with Rev. Andy Huff officiating.
