Mr. Jimmy Pat Coile, 75, of Hull, GA passed away on Thursday, June 24, 2021, at St. Mary's Hospital in Athens, GA.

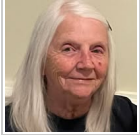

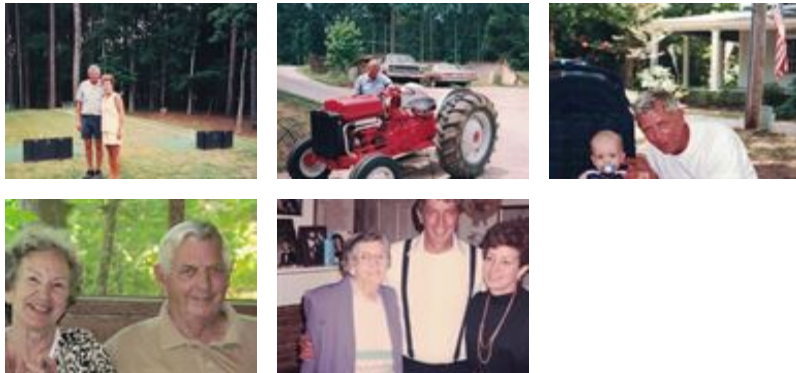
