Mr. Jimmy Rogers Coker, 68, of Colbert, GA passed away on Friday, October 25, 2013, at the St. Mary's Hospice House in Bogart, GA.

Mr. Coker was born in Royston, GA on April 16, 1945, son of the late L.T. Coker and the late Mary King Coker.
