Mr. Jimmy Lee Hill, 71, of Royston, GA, passed away on Monday, February 18, 2019. Born September 25, 1947, he was the son of the late George Kelly Hill and Winnie Boles Hill Roach.

Mr. Hill was a graduate of Franklin County High School - Class of 1965. Upon graduating, he enlisted in The United States Navy and served active duty on The U.S.S. New Jersey during Vietnam.
