January 29, 1943 - July 21, 2022

Mr. Joseph Perry Hart, 79, of Canon, GA passed away on Thursday, July 21, 2022, at his home.

Mr. Hart was born in the Sandy Cross Community on January 29, 1943, son of the late Jack O'Dell Hart and the late Katie Bell Haley Hart. He was a drafter and engineer having worked for AWH- Royston Corporation and was a member of New Franklin Christian Church. Mr. Hart was also a founding member of the Five Area Fire Department where he served as Training Officer and then Chief until his retirement.

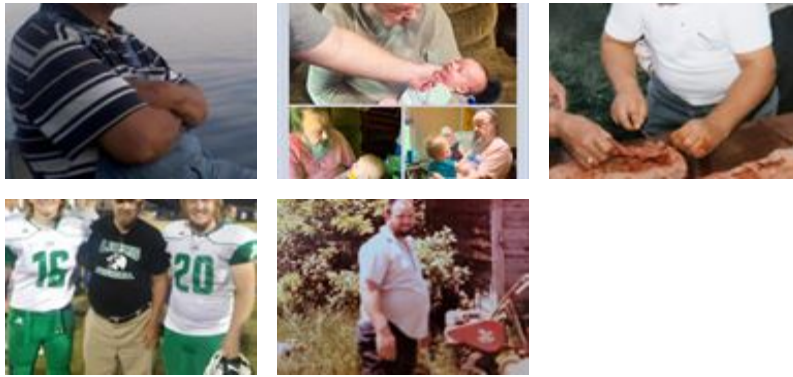
