Mr. Lawrence Eugene Bragg, 74, of Royston, GA passed away in the Philippines on Sunday, June 16, 2024.

Mr. Bragg was born in Atlanta, GA on April 26, 1950, son of the late Calvin Coolidge Bragg, Sr. and the late Donna Geneva Scoggins Bragg. He was a thirty-three year retired Sergeant-Major in the United States Army. Mr. Bragg was of the Pentecostal Holiness Faith and a Mason.
