Mr. Levon Calvin Register, Sr., 85, of Franklin Springs, GA (formerly of Signal Mountain, TN) passed away on Tuesday, August 13, 2013, at the St. Mary's Hospital in Athens, GA.

Mr. Register was born in Vero Beach, FL on October 23, 1927, son of the late Abbott D. Register and the late Ivy Benton Register. He was a certified public accountant having worked with Arthur Anderson & Company and attended the Franklin Springs Pentecostal Holiness Church. He was a member of the Emmanuel College Board of Education for 35 years and a U.S. Navy Veteran. Mr. Register was preceded in death by his wife, Elmaise Turnage Register.
