Mrs. Lucretia Delores Hodgen Pritchett, 76, of Royston, GA passed away on Friday, May 1, 2026, at the Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center.

Mrs. Pritchett was born in Jamestown, NC on September 26, 1949, daughter of the late Maragret Hodgen. She was a teacher for 33 years, having taught kindergarten for 20 years with the Franklin County School System. 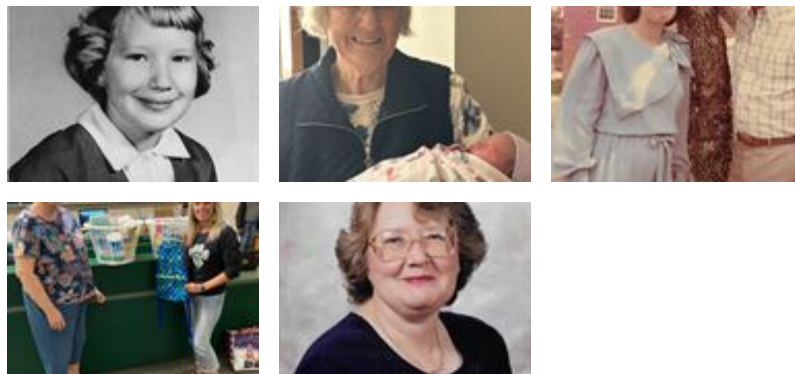
