



## Mr. Mack Clinton Floyd

November 1, 1931 - February 4, 2016

Mr. Mack Clinton Floyd, 84, of Royston, GA passed away on Thursday, February 04, 2016, at his home.

Mr. Floyd was born on November 1, 1931, son of the late Clayton Floyd and the late Bessie Weaver Floyd. Mr. Floyd was the Chief of Police having worked for the City of Royston Police Department. He was also a member of the Peace Officers Association, an honorary lifetime member of the Georgia Association of Chief of Police, the Royston Volunteer Fire Department, and a United States Army Veteran. 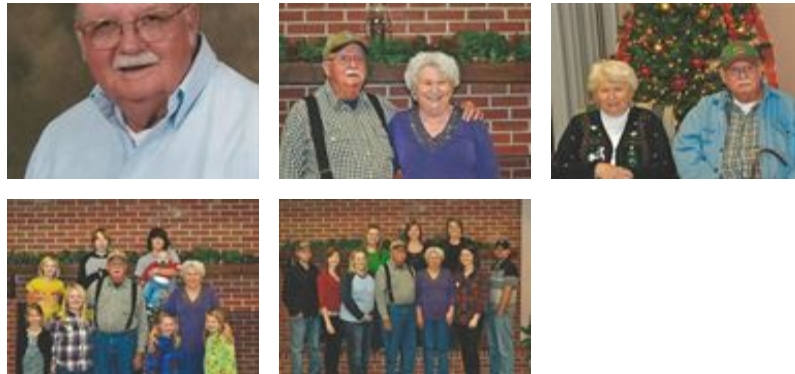
