



## Mr. Marshall Hayes

January 5, 1946 - March 13, 2020

Mr. Marshall Hayes, 74, of Lavonia, GA passed away on Friday, March 13, 2020, at the Northeast Georgia Medical Center in Gainesville, GA.

Mr. Hayes was born in Royston, GA on January 5, 1946, son of the late Hollis Henry Hayes and the late Miriam Wingfield Hayes. He worked at Johnson & Johnson for 19 years and retired from Caterpillar. 

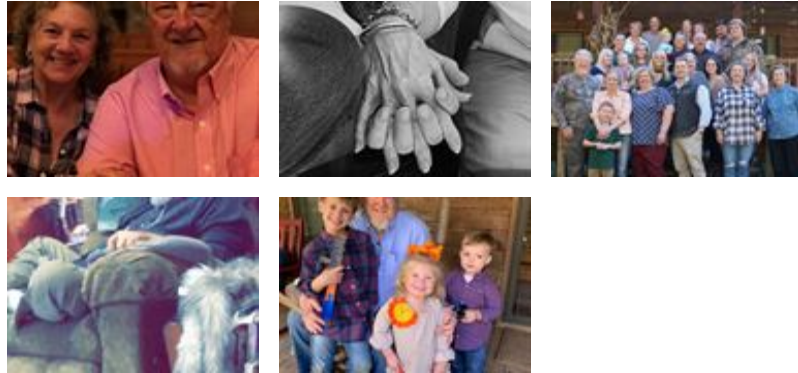
