Mrs. Phyllis Grace Mayberry Dickinson, 74, of Danielsville, GA, passed away peacefully on Thursday, May 25, 2023, at St. Mary's Hospice House in Athens, GA.

Mrs. Dickinson was born in Opelika, AL, on January 17, 1949, daughter of the late Joseph Preston Mayberry and the late Frances Grace Mayberry. 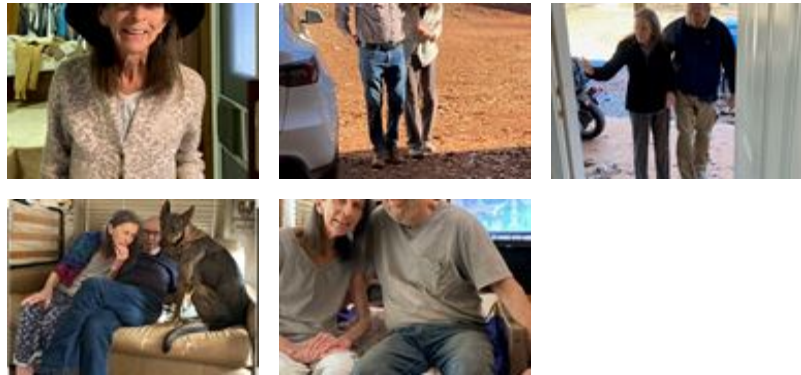
