Mr. Randy Phillip Holloway, 76, of Danielsville, GA passed away on Friday, October 18, 2024, at the Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center in Athens, GA.

Mr. Holloway was born in Royston, GA on August 28, 1948, son of the late Robert Harrison Holloway and the late Corene Porterfield Holloway. He was a repair operator having worked at Duplicating Systems for 23 years and thoroughly enjoyed refinishing old cars and tractors in his spare time. Mr. Holloway was also a member of Riverside Baptist Church in Royston.

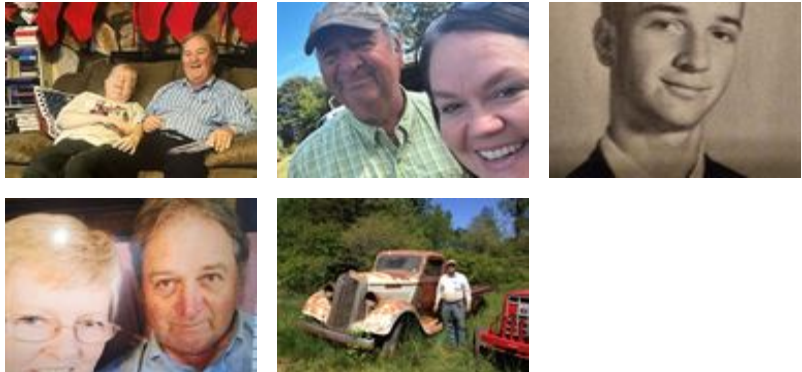
