A celebration of life for Mr. Goff will be held at a later date.

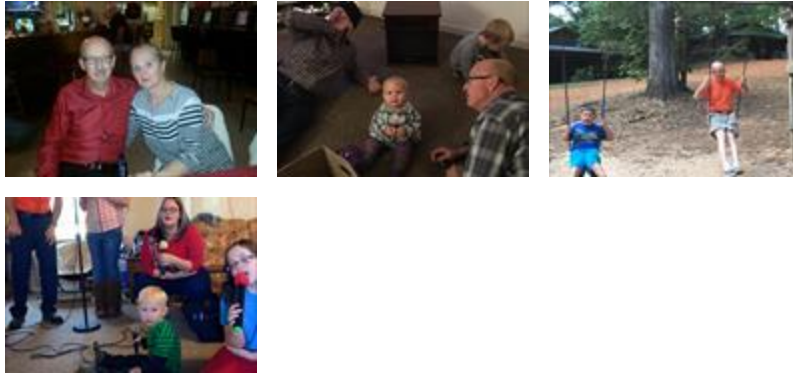

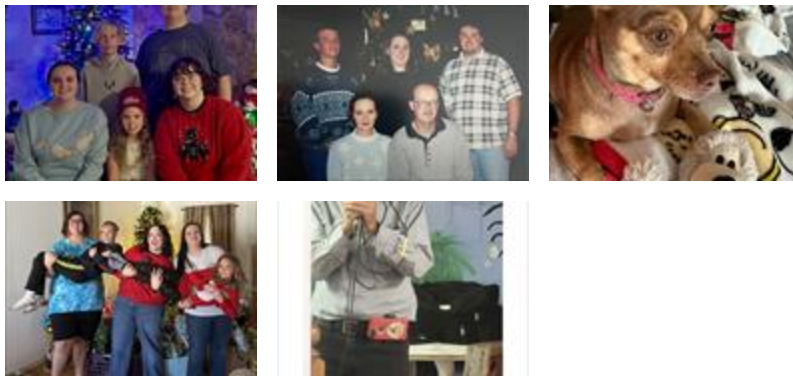
