Mr. Roger Hugh Kirk, 69, of Danielsville, GA passed away on Tuesday, May 9, 2017, at Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center in Athens, GA.

Mr. Kirk was born on July 10, 1947 in Royston, GA, son of the late Charles Leonard Kirk and the late Margaret Beard Kirk. He was an electrical engineer having worked at Baldor and an Air Force veteran where he served during the Vietnam Era. He attended Ila Baptist Church.

Roger was instrumental in raising proceeds to benefit cystic fibrosis through "Show and Shine" car show in Helen, GA.
