



## Mr. Roy Clifton Gandy

October 24, 1930 - May 23, 2025

Mr. Roy Clifton Gandy, 94, of Royston, GA passed away on Friday, May 23, 2025, at the Piedmont Athens Regional Medical Center. The nurse's timeframe was 2 to 24 hours till death, Roy took 5 days, always beating the odds.

Mr. Gandy was born in Honey Island, TX on October 24, 1930, son of the late Mitchel and Lela Gandy. He was a United States Navy Veteran having served during the Korean War and then went on to retire from the United States Forest Service.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sons, Mitchell Gandy and Don Gandy; and his six brothers and seven sisters.

Survivors include his wife, Barbara Gandy; daughter, Beverly (John) Steffel; seven grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

Roy has been described as stubborn, competitive, hardworking and willing to help whenever and wherever he was needed. Because of these characteristics, he was instrumental in starting the Madison County Rotary Club Ramp Program for the handicapped. He was also instrumental in bringing the Senior Center to Madison County. Because of who he was, he has touched and changed many lives.

A memorial service for Mr. Gandy will be held at a later date. In lieu of flowers, memorials may be made to the Madison County Rotary Club Ramp Program or to Royston First United Methodist Church
