Mr. S.A. Long, 91, of 2992 Old Maysville Road, Commerce, GA passed away Tuesday, May 07, 2013 at the Northridge Medical Center in Commerce, GA.

Mr. Long was born on June 11, 1921, son of the late Samuel H. Long and the late Ellen Branyon Long. He was married to the late Sarah Tiller Long for 61 years. Mr. Long was the last surviving member of his family. He was preceded in death by four brothers and seven sisters. Mr. Long was retired from Roper Pump Company, a member of Mt.
