Mr. Sherman Chaney Payne, 61, of Carnesville, GA, passed away peacefully with his family by his side on Sunday, October 6, 2019, at his home.

Mr. Payne was born on December 7, 1957 in Toccoa, GA, son of the late George Lee Payne and the late Bonnie Sue Cobb Payne. He was Captain of Investigations with the Hart County Sheriff's Department and served in law enforcement for 38 years. Mr. Payne was a member of the Toccoa Masonic Lodge and the Royston Church of God.
