Mr. Vernon Ray Segars, 76, of Canon, GA passed away on Thursday, September 1, 2022, at his home.

Mr. Segars was born in Royston, GA on November 23, 1945, son of the late Carl Harrison Segars and the late Annie Sue Vaughn Segars. He was the owner, operator and mechanic of Segars Auto Sales and was of the Baptist faith.
